## ICSFT DENOUNCES THE SENSELESS KILLING OF SALEH AL-SAMMAD

The head of Yemen's Supreme Political Council Saleh al-Sammad has been killed on Thursday by Saudi-led air strikes on Hodeidah province. ICSFT expresses its deepest condolences for the people of Yemen for the passing of Saleh al-Sammad, president of Yemen's Supreme Political Council.

The late Saleh Ali al-Sammad was the head of the Yemeni Supreme Political Council, an executive body formed by Ansarullah Movement and the General People's Congress (GPC) on 28 July 2016 to govern Yemen.

Saleh al-Sammad was an influential figure in Yemen's resistance against a more than three years Saudi-led and USA backed genocidal war on Yemen.

The Yemeni Supreme Political Council appointed Mehdi Mohammad Hussein al-Mashat as its new chairman.

Although the Saudi led genocidal campaign against Yemen has entered its fourth year causing immeasurable catastrophe with complete impunity, this illegal war will only strengthen the solidarity movement of Yemeni people to defend their country from the invading powers, Saudi Arabia and its GCC and Western allies

The Yemeni Ministry of Human Rights announced on March 25 that the Saudi-led war had left 600,000 civilians dead and injured during the past three years.

The United Nations says a record 22.2 million people are in need of food aid. Including 8.4 million threatened by severe hunger. UN aid agency also warned against the catastrophic living conditions in Yemen, stating that there was a growing risk of famine and cholera there.

ICSFT categorically denounces such heinous act by the Saudi led and USA backed coalition against innocent people of Yemen and calls for an end to this senseless war on Yemen!
