Trump's war mongering with the Iran nuclear deal

As ICSFT has noted in the past, the current situation with the P5+1 nuclear deal is tenuous. Iran has fulfilled its obligations to the international community and the P5+1 group as per the agreement guidelines, including cutting its stockpile of uranium by 98%, and reduce its gas centrifuges- another critical component in the creation of nuclear weapons- by two thirds over the following 13 years. Iran agreed to these and several other addition restrictions on processes and substances related to the creation of nuclear weapons, in exchange for an end to economic sanctions by the P5+ 1 states.

Yet- the hypocritical US administration has not held up its end of the bargain. US is threatening to enforce sanctions on Iran in spite of the latter having fulfilled all aspects of its obligations.

In particular Trump has been erratically and dangerously bullying of Iran.

In defense, Iran's Iranian Foreign Minister Mohammad Javad Zarif has stated: "We have put a number of options for ourselves, and those options are ready including options that would involve resuming at a much greater speed our nuclear activities." Considering the hypocrisy by the United States, and the terms of the nuclear agreement, this response seems measured.

After meeting with Trump last week, Macron stated that he believes Trump will pull out of his obligations to the nuclear deal, and that this will lead to war.

Such behaviour is shameful, irresponsible and hypocritical. Innocent lives are at stake in this game of proxy war.

The UK Foreign Minister Boris Johnson remarked he regretted the US no longer taking part in the nuclear deal.

As well "The EU will remain committed to the continued full and effective implementation of the nuclear deal," Mogherini said from Brussels.

The United Nations Secretary-General Antonio Guterres said "It is essential that all concerns regarding the implementation of the plan be addressed through the mechanisms established in the JCPOA. Issues not directly related to the JCPOA should be addressed without prejudice to preserving the agreement and its accomplishments,"

Trump and his allies do not have the right or authority to impose sanctions on Iran when Iran has been upholding its agreed upon duties to the international community. ICSFT calls upon states including the 5 +1- China, France, Russia, the United Kingdom, and the United States, plus Germany, and the European Union- to stop acting with violent hypocrisy, and to step up against an international bully- and truly support the international agreements that are the foundation and cornerstone of diplomacy and peace

ICSFT unequivocally denounces the United States move to unilaterally change negotiated treaties ranging from the Iran nuclear deal to the global-warming pact and world trade rules. We reject unilateralism as they should not be the unspoken yet dominant foreign policy tool as practiced by the US.

ICSFT calls on the international community to jointly oppose such unilateralism and blatant violation of internationally rules.
