ICSFT MEDIA CAMPAIGN ON SAUDI IMPOSED YEMEN GENOCIDAL WAR

'According to the UN, Yemen could become the worst humanitarian disaster in half a century, with as many as 76% of the population in need of humanitarian aid'

The devastating war on Yemen by the Saudi-led coalition that has resulted in the deaths of thousands of civilians and driven the country to the brink of famine has entered its fourth year accompanied by the deafening international silence!

Saudi led military coalition is carrying out a devastating air bombardment campaign in Yemen that could amount to war crimes. The coalition airstrikes which have struck civilian infrastructure including health facilities, schools, factories, power facilities, bridges and roads is a clear violation of the Law of the War. More often than not such strikes have been disproportionate or indiscriminate and in many cases they appear to have directly target civilians and, or civilian objects.

ICSFT condemns in the strongest term the war crimes carried out by the Saudi-led forces and their western allies , mainly the US and UK, over the past three years and calls for the UN and international community to put an end to the genocidal war in Yemen
